

STROKE ORDER

It is important to follow the correct stroke order in order to write good Japanese characters. The rule is basically from left to right, from top to bottom.

DIRECTIONS

Basic direction of each stroke is from left to right, from top to bottom.

to (5) LIFT


The small hook which originated in brush writing is made with a smooth lift. In hiragana, a lift is optional in most cases.

Especially with dots in う,え,お,な,ふ,む and ら, the lift should be minimum or none.

This should not be too big (long) in hand writing, although it is exaggerated in typed style.

▶ RELEASE

The smooth release which originated in brush writing is made with a gradual release. Just let your pencil go smoothly.
